Hi Nacho and Alfonso, your progress on the data paper/database is very exciting! Impressive work!

I have a bunch of new results for the modeling paper that I am interested to discuss with you--let me put them together into slides and we can set up a call.

Alfonso, here are the lat-longs for the ICP sites. Quick note for safe data processing: these site id numbers are unique within a crop-region and match the site ids in the data I sent, but they are not unique across crop-regions (for instance watermelon california site 1,2,3,etc are different from watermelon florida site 1,2,3,etc).

Also, while making this and checking the lat-longs, I noticed a mistake in the last california almond file I sent you--there should not be a site 6, instead it is just site 1 in a different year. Here's the corrected csv. Let me know if you have any questions!

I'll get back to you on the Winfree data this evening. I've been in touch with Rachael about it, and she had some comments which I am checking.
